Physical Examinations of Students**

Students are required to obtain physical examinations beginning with 7th grade and are required to have a physical examination performed each two years thereafter, prior to practice and competition in athletics. The examination should be performed no earlier than May 1 of the preceding school year. Additionally, students participating in football are required to have an annual physical. The physical examination must be conducted by a physician possessing an unrestricted license to practice medicine, a licensed naturopathic physician, a licensed physician assistant, a certified nurse practitioner or a licensed chiropractic physician who has clinical training and experience in detecting cardiopulmonary diseases and defects.

The district may require a student have an additional physical examination if he/she has had an injury, surgery, diagnosis or significant disease or illness in the past year.

A student new to the district is required to have a physical examination if he/she has not had the required Oregon medical examination or its equivalent.

Any participant who has an injury or illness and has been under the care of a physician must have a "Return to Play" form signed by the physician before participation.
