

Student Fees, Fines and Charges **

Implementation of Board policy JN shall have these provisions:

1. The student's parents shall be given written notice of the intent to deny participation in graduation ceremonies at least 10 days in advance of the actual denial. Notice shall include itemization of outstanding charges;
2. The parents may request a hearing during the 10 days in advance of the denial. A disposition decision must be made and given to the parents prior to the actual denial;
3. The principal may grant the parent's request to substitute work for an amount owed.
 - a. Either the student or the parent may perform the work.
 - b. The principal will design the tasks keeping in mind the age and/or skill level of the worker.
 - c. Compensation will be the equivalent of minimum wage.
 - d. Work will be rounded up to the nearest one-half hour.
 - e. The principal has the option of refusing to use the student's labor as compensation when the student's labor would not provide equivalent value.
4. Money owed to the cafeteria is not included in this provision.
