Delayed Graduation

Any student who has not reached 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the school year and has not graduated from high school may attend for completion of graduation requirements. A person past the age of 18 or who has been in attendance in high school for four years may return to school on a planned program to finish graduation requirements.

The planned program will be agreed upon by the student, counselor and principal and will consist of a minimum of a two period day. The plan may include work experience for part of the four periods. Regular attendance will also be part of the planned program. A person completing a delayed graduation program will receive a diploma or certificate of competency dated the year he/she finishes.

A student who has not reached 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the school year and is receiving special education services and has not received a regular high school diploma shall attend school for the remainder of the year.
