2. Provide direction and opportunities for the student to use technology and to develop problem solving and decision making processes;
3. Provide an environment that will help the student select, evaluate and fulfill present and future goals;
4. Develop a student's potential and pride in his/her unique capabilities by helping the student recognize individual strengths and limitations;
5. Help the student be aware of and respect the values, traditions and lifestyles of his/her culture and the cultures of others;
6. Help the student realize that every living thing has value and is worthy of respect;
7. Help the student realize that his/her decisions affect other people and each student is responsible and accountable for his/her own actions;
8. Make optimum use of equipment, facilities, personnel and community resources in the education of the community;
9. Provide learning experiences that are rewarding, motivating and meaningful;
10. Develop school improvement plans based on such information as provided by district and school self-evaluations;
11. Continually adapt educational and evaluation programs to each learner's needs and capabilities;
12. Help the student develop a positive self-image;

13. Help the student become adaptable;
14. Identify and promote teaching and learning conditions that promote effective teaching practices and increase student achievement;
15. Administer grant-in-aid for the professional development of staff;
16. Develop plans to improve the professional growth and career opportunities of staff.
