

Orientation of New Board Members

A new member is to be afforded the Board's and staff's fullest measure of courtesy and cooperation. Board and staff will make every effort to assist the new member to become fully informed about the Board's functions, policies, procedures, and problems. In the interim between appointment and actually assuming office, the new Board member(s) will be assisted in the following ways:

- a. The electee will be given materials on the role of a member of the school Board;
- b. The electee will be invited to attend Board meetings to observe the operation of the Board but will not be a voting member;
- c. The electee will be given a copy of Board policies;
- d. The superintendent will supply material pertinent to meetings and will explain its content;
- e. The incoming member will be invited to meet with the superintendent and other administrative personnel, by arrangement with the superintendent, to discuss services they perform for the district;
- f. The electee will be encouraged to attend the Summer Board Conference and Leadership Academy sponsored by the Oregon School Boards Association;
- g. New Board members will receive all reports and communications normally sent to Board members.
