Recycling of wastes can reduce the volume of landfill materials in a major way.

The Board encourages each school to make all reasonable efforts to participate in recycling efforts that are offered in the local community.

The Board encourages resource conservation in the school district.

The Board supports the following actions:

1. Full utilization of materials prior to disposal;
2. Limited use of disposable materials;
3. Limited use of non-biodegradable products;
4. The purchase of recycled products, when it is financially viable.
