## Use of Tobacco

### Tobacco-Free Environment

The district recognizes that tobacco may create a health hazard for nonusers as well as users. In order to protect the health of students, staff and the general public, provide a healthy working environment and promote good health for students and staff alike, tobacco use shall be prohibited on all district property and in district-owned vehicles.

Tobacco use prohibited signs will be posted in appropriate locations in all district buildings and on district property.

The effective date of this policy shall be March 1, 2003. Building administrators, in consultation with building staff, may implement this policy prior to the effective date.
