

Work Experience/Release Program

All high school students are expected to be enrolled in classes equal to the number of daily class periods, unless participating in an approved work experience, alternative program, or other educational endeavor. One of the classes may be a study hall if so approved by the principal.

Seniors in good academic standing and enrolled in a minimum of four classes may qualify for early dismissal during the regular school day so that they may work. This privilege may be revoked for attendance, behavior, or credit problems.

Select juniors may qualify for work experience programs with parent, counselor, and building administrator consent.
