Student Fees, Fines and Charges

The Board may assess fees for specified services provided to students by the district.

A textbook deposit may be established for books provided for student use in grades 9 through 12. Students may be excused from payment of the deposit if payment would constitute a hardship or if the student chooses to provide books by some other means. This deposit will be returned upon satisfactory return of the books.

A fee may be charged by the district for use of physical education uniforms and towels. Students may be excused from payment of the fee if payment would constitute a hardship or if the student provides proper uniform and towel by some other means.

The Board will establish the charge to be made to students for lunches provided by the district. Free and reduced price lunches will be offered to students who qualify under the district lunch policy.

The superintendent is authorized to assess fines/fees for lost or damaged items to include all school property.

A student body membership fee may be charged for services provided by the students for the students. The amount of the fee will be established by the student organization with the advice of the principal and subject to annual approval by the Board.

Any student organization may require a fee for participation in activities of the group.

All student organizational assessed fees shall be voluntary. No student will be required to pay for services used that are provided by the group.
