

Use of Feature Films/Videos in the School**

Only films/videos rated G, PG, or PG-13 may be shown as part of the school program.

The showing of all feature films/videos with a G rating requires only general parent notification at the beginning of a school year by the instructor.

Feature films/videos with a PG or PG-13 rating that are proposed to be shown in school must receive permission from the building principal at least five days prior to the showing. Approval of the principal must be secured prior to discussing with students the possible showing of the film/video.

Instructors should preview all film media before showing to students unless it has only a G rating.

Additionally, for feature films/videos with a PG or PG-13 rating, prior parental consent will be required before a student views the films.

Films/videos containing profane or obscene language and/or nudity will be shown only at the high school level and must have the permission of the principal at least five days prior to the showing. The film must be a “classic”. The instructor should inform the principal the purpose of the showing; how it meets the course objectives; and the provisions of how parents will be notified, or if necessary grant consent for their child to view the film.
