Early Entrance

A student will be admitted in the first grade if his/her sixth birthday occurs on or before September 1, as established by law. In addition, a student whose sixth birthday occurs after that date may be admitted to the first grade if he/she:

1. Is a first grade student transferring from a public school in another district, or from a private school;
2. Completed a successful year in a public kindergarten the previous year and would be continuing his/her formal education.

A student will be admitted to kindergarten if his/her fifth birthday occurs one year earlier than the date established by law for entry into the first grade, or is a kindergarten student transferring from a public school in another district.

Early entry into school will be allowed for a student whose fifth/sixth birthday occurs after September 1, but not later than November 15 and who is sufficiently advanced to succeed in the educational program based on an analysis by qualified professional staff of his/her:

1. Intellectual functioning;
2. Emotional/social functioning;
3. Adaptive behavior (including but not limited to: perceptual and motor skills, self-help skills and communication skills).

The superintendent shall identify screening processes and instruments which will provide a dependable assessment of the preceding criteria. The superintendent shall determine, based upon the above, if the student is to be admitted or denied admittance. The superintendent's decision is not appealable to the Board.

Parents will be required to pay the cost of the special testing involved.
