

## Student Dress and Grooming

Responsibility for dress and grooming rests primarily with students and their parents; however, the district expects student dress and grooming to meet standards which insure that the following conditions do not exist:

1. Disruption or interference with the classroom learning environment.
2. Threat to the health and/or safety of the student concerned or of other students.
3. Promoting or advertising items or conduct that are prohibited in the school such as drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and nudity, etc.
4. Wearing clothing that is offensive to staff or students such as showing undergarments, belly buttons, bare feet, shorts less than mid-thigh, and loose or baggy items (tank tops, armless T-shirts, etc.).

Students who represent the school in a voluntary activity may be required to conform to dress and grooming standards approved by the superintendent and may be denied the opportunity to participate if those standards are not met.
