

School-Community Relations Goals and Objectives

The Board encourages the use of the widest appropriate means to promote greater understanding between the district and the community in order that the district will recognize and provide for the needs of the community. Every attempt will be made by the Board to represent the people of the community in acting in the interests of their children.

To this end:

- A. The Board will provide appropriate means for keeping the community informed regarding the policies and direction of the district, and will provide citizens, individuals as well as groups, with opportunities to raise questions, express views and discuss district issues with the Board and staff.
- B. It will be the responsibility of all personnel employed in the school district to assist the Board in its effort to create greater understanding between the schools and the community.
- C. Parents and other residents of the district will be invited and encouraged to visit the district and to observe in any and all classrooms, providing that such visitors register themselves at the school office when entering the school district and conduct themselves in such a way that classroom work is not disrupted.
- D. School district patrons will be invited to serve as members of school committees formed for the purpose of improving the district.
- E. Other methods of creating greater understanding between the school and the community will be continually explored under the leadership of the superintendent and the administrative staff.
