Admissions to District Events

All spectators in the district will be assessed the uniform district rate for extracurricular activities. Spectators are defined as patrons who attend extracurricular activities for the purpose of entertainment. There are no exceptions for endowment games or play-off games.

Exceptions to the above are as follows:

1. Senior citizens age 65+ will be admitted free;
2. Tri-Valley Conference, Oregon High School Coaches Association and Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) Media passes will be honored;
3. Participants designated by the principal or athletic director with responsibility at extracurricular activities will be admitted free of charge. Participants would include, but not be limited to, students, parents or district patrons;
4. Children under age five, accompanied by an adult, may be admitted free;
5. All events held in high school gyms and the stadium will be charged entrance fees as set by the current league.

District employees and Board members will be assessed the uniform district admission rate. Such individuals may be admitted at no charge only when assigned specific duties and such admission is consistent with the provisions of ORS Chapter 244.

Board members may be reimbursed, when paid admission is required of the general public, for attending district sporting events and other activities as part of their responsibilities of being informed about district operations.
