Early Entrance**

A student who is six years of age will be admitted into a public school if his/her sixth birthday occurs on or before September 1. A student whose sixth birthday occurs after that date may be admitted to the first grade if he/she has maintained regular attendance in any grade of a public full-time school during the entire school term.

A student will be admitted to kindergarten if his/her fifth birthday occurs on or before September 1 or is a kindergarten student transferring from a public school in another district.

Early entry into kindergarten may be allowed for a student whose 5th birthday occurs between September 1 and November 1 and whose needs would best be met in the school program based on an analysis by qualified professional staff of his/her:

- 1. Cognitive development;
- 2. Language development;
- 3. Math readiness skills:
- 4. Reading readiness skills;
- 5. Social development;
- 6. Physical development and stamina to attend full-day kindergarten.

The superintendent shall identify screening processes and instruments which will provide a dependable assessment of the preceding criteria.

Parents will be required to pay the cost of any special testing involved.
