School Closures

Because of declining enrollment and resources, the Board believes that its obligation to provide equal education opportunity district wide may not permit the continued operation of all schools. Therefore, the Board believes that a school should be closed upon demonstration that it cannot maintain, without additional resources, efficient operation of a program meeting district criteria¹. The superintendent shall develop administrative procedures for school closure which will be used to demonstrate a need for closure of any building.
