Attendance**

Goals of attendance requirements are to:

1. Contribute to the academic success of students;
2. Inform parents/guardians about their students' class attendance or nonattendance;
3. Place the responsibility for attendance in the hands of students and their parents/guardians;
4. Aid students in making decisions and accepting the responsibilities and consequences resulting from those decisions;
5. Stress that punctual and regular attendance is a learned function necessary for many areas of life;
6. Stress that attendance may impact students' skill development, academic progress, and students' demonstration of proficiency in their courses and, as a result, may impact grades and credit;
7. Promote equity in 4J schools' work with students and families.
8. Meet Oregon graduation requirements.

Each school shall notify parents/guardians by the end of the school day if their child has an unplanned absence. The notification will be either in person, by telephone or via another method identified in writing by the parent/guardian. If the parent/guardian cannot be notified by the above methods, a message shall be left, if possible.

The Board directs the superintendent to develop rules and regulations which meet these objectives and to publish those rules and regulations annually for students and their parents/guardians.
