Eligibility to Attend

All persons seeking admission to the district must satisfactorily meet all academic, age, immunization, tuition and other eligibility prerequisites for admission as set forth in state and federal law, Board policy and administrative regulations. All candidates for admission will be informed of admission requirements.

Unsheltered Students

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission solely because the student does not have a fixed place of residence or solely because the student is not under the supervision of a parent.

Enrollment Age Criteria

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission where they are otherwise eligible, and not yet attained the age of 20 during the current school year. A child entering school for the first time shall be considered to be 5 years of age if his or her fifth birthday occurs on or before September 1.

The district may admit an otherwise eligible person who is not receiving special education and who has not yet attained 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year if the person is shown to be in need of additional education in order to receive a diploma.

Students Expelled From Other School Districts

The district may deny regular school admission to a student who is expelled from another school district and who subsequently becomes a resident of the district or who applies for admission to the district as a nonresident student. In order to deny admission to a student who becomes a resident of this district, the administrator must follow the procedures outlined in the district's expulsion procedures.

The district shall deny regular school admission to a student who is expelled from another school district for an offense that constitutes a violation of state or federal weapons laws and who subsequently becomes a resident of the district or who applies for admission as a nonresident student.

The school administration shall inform a student who becomes a resident of the district and the student's parents about the availability of alternative education programs if the student's admission is denied because he or she has been expelled from another school district.
