Student Transfers

It is the goal of Falls City School District #57 to provide high quality education experiences for each resident child living within its administrative boundaries. To the degree possible the district will also make available to children residing outside the district's administrative boundaries educational opportunities equal to those provided for resident students.

Oregon law provides that the school district in which the school age child resides is to provide for a public education for children, grades K-12. It is, therefore, the policy of the Board and the district that out of district transfers will not be allowed except:

1. In extraordinary circumstances where the district cannot meet specific educational needs of its students. These transfers will be accepted at any time, may be approved without Board consultation by the Superintendent, and require only ratification by the Board.

This policy covers any and all claims of approved transfer status by any student who is a resident of Falls City School District currently enrolled in a public school in another district. However, it is the intent of the Board by resolution to approve resident transfers for students continuing to attend the same non-district public school in a subsequent year.
