

Accident Prevention and Safety Procedures

Through its comprehensive safety program, the district will attempt to prevent accidents by assuring a safe working and learning environment. Warning systems such as smoke detectors will be installed and maintained; accident prevention and safety instruction will be given students and staff; safety procedures will be taught; and other precautions will be taken in order to attempt to eliminate accidents and harmful situations in the district.

The superintendent will ensure that sufficient funds are requested from the Board budget committee each budgetary period for the upkeep of district services in accordance with Board policy DA – Fiscal Management Goals.
