

Emergency Procedures and Disaster Plans

Emergency Procedures

The superintendent will develop and maintain a plan specifying procedures to be used in such emergencies as disorderly behavior, unlawful assembly, disturbances at school activities, natural disasters, fire, illness or injury of a student or staff member, and use of force on district property. The superintendent will consult with community and county agencies while developing this plan.

The emergency procedures plan so developed will meet or exceed minimum standards of the State Board of Education.

Copies of the emergency procedures plan will be available in every school office and other unit offices. Parents will be informed of the district's plan for care of students during an emergency situation.

Disaster Plans

In case of emergency or disaster, a mass evacuation of students will be carried out in the following manner:

- The superintendent or designee will direct buses and drivers to the appropriate loading areas;
- Scheduled runs will be combined into maximum capacity single runs;
- District staff will institute crowd control measures to insure safe, efficient loading of students.
