

Student Performances

Theatrical coach will submit the title and script of each production planned, to the school administrator for review, at least 20 days prior to commencement of tryouts.

The school administrator will approve or disapprove the proposal within ten school days of receipt.

Once a proposed production has been approved, and rehearsals have commenced, the production may not be altered, censored or halted, except at the discretion of the theatrical coach or by action of the superintendent, and/or the Board.

If a proposed production is not approved, the ruling administrator must include a written statement describing the criteria for rejection of a production to the theatrical coach, district superintendent and Board.

Upon receipt of the written notification of rejection, the theatrical coach may appeal the decision to the district superintendent. Notification of the appeal must be sent to the superintendent, the school administrator, and the Board.

The superintendent may sustain or overrule the rejection of a proposed production. A written ruling by the superintendent must be sent to the Theatrical coach, school administrator, and the Board within ten school days. Should the Superintendent not issue a ruling the issue may then be referred to the Board for public discussion and a final decision.
