

**Discipline for Use, Possession, Distribution or Sale of Tobacco
Products or Inhalant Delivery Systems**

The following procedures will be used for students who violate the district's policy on use, possession, distribution or sale of tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems:

Relevant consequences for athletes who have signed a contract will also apply.

First Offense

Depending on the specifics of the violation, consequences may range from student/parent conference, to detention, to one day of in or out of school suspension.

Second Offense

Suspension in or out of school for 1-2 school days.

Third Offense

May include up to 3 days of in or out of school suspension. Consequences may also include a cessation program completion with cost to be the responsibility of the student and his/her parent.

Alternative and or addition to Discipline

Students may be referred to a cessation and/or tobacco education class at any point. Attendance at such classes is voluntary. Any cost related to cessation classes is the responsibility of the student and his/her parent. The district may also require the successful completion of a behavior modification plan.

Other

A referral to law enforcement and/or public health authority may be made at any time.
