

Corporal Punishment**

Corporal punishment is defined as the willful infliction of, or willfully causing the infliction of, physical pain on a student. It includes the intentional use of physical force upon a student for any alleged offense or behavior, or the use of physical force in an attempt to modify the behavior, thought or attitudes of a student.

The use of corporal punishment in any form is strictly prohibited in the district. No student will be subject to the infliction of corporal punishment by any teacher, other student, administrator or other district personnel.

No teacher, administrator, student or other person will subject a student to corporal punishment or condone the use of corporal punishment by any person under his or her supervision or control. Permission to administer corporal punishment will not be sought or accepted from any parent, guardian or district official.
