## Curriculum Development

The Board has the responsibility for maintaining a minimum program of instruction guaranteed by state statutes and of initiating improvement beyond that minimum.

Accordingly, after planning by the staff and with the approval of the administration, all new programs and courses of study, as well as the elimination and extensive alteration of the content of current programs and courses, will be presented by the assistant superintendent/chief academic officer to the Board for its consideration and action.

### Evaluation of the Instructional Program

The Board expects the staff and administration to evaluate the educational program. Such evaluation may be expected to lead to recommendations for modifications of practice, changes in content and new course offerings.

After planning by staff and administration and approval by the assistant superintendent/chief academic officer new course offerings or deletions will be presented to the Board for its approval.

### Planned Course Statements

All high school courses will be described in a Planned Course Statement which will include: (1) course title; (2) credit awarded; (3) course overview, including prerequisite requirements; (4) course outcomes for students; and (5) district curriculum frameworks, benchmarks and indicators.
