

Driver Education/Traffic Safety Education

The following procedures shall be used in implementing the district's driver education program.

Tuition Rate

Each year the superintendent will propose a tuition rate.

Nonresident Student Enrollment

Each August the superintendent will identify districts that might benefit from the district's driver education program.

The superintendent will send a letter inviting non-resident student application. Such application shall establish a "waiting list." The waiting list shall be based upon a "first come, first served" basis. When the resident student enrollment is established, the waiting list will be activated.

All students shall be subject to the district's code of conduct, policies and regulations. Violation may result in disciplinary action to include denial in the driver education program.

Reduction or Waived Tuition

When a student requests a waiver or reduction of the established fee for driver education, a review committee consisting of the driver education instructor and the building administrator shall review the request.

The administrator shall only consider students who qualify for free or reduced price meals under the federal lunch program or students whose family believes the tuition is a severe hardship.

Tuition waivers or reductions may result in:

1. Accessing a fund set aside to assist needy students;
2. Setting up a work program with the student;
3. Setting up a "payment plan";
4. Other.
