Cocurricular Activities

Because cocurricular activities foster learning which complements the school's primary mission of providing a strong basic and academic education, care will be taken to ensure that the appropriate balance exists between the two.

Whenever or wherever held, when conducted under the name of the district, a school or any class or organization thereof, cocurricular activities will be under the supervision of district employees and subject to all rules, regulations and standards of conduct which govern such activities.
