Web Pages

The district encourages the publication of web pages to foster improved communication about its programs, services and student learning with parents, patrons, students, universities, colleges and other agencies. The district recognizes, however, that any personal information or image that is published on the Internet could be misused. This policy, therefore, is intended to balance the interest of improved communication with the need for protecting student and staff safety and security.

Information provided on web pages through any of the district's facilities or equipment should be checked by the supervising staff person for accuracy and compliance with all the guidelines in IIBGB-AR. Failure to comply with this policy and applicable administrative regulations may result in discipline, up to and including expulsion and/or suspension of district Internet privileges for students and possible dismissal and/or referral to Teacher Standards and Practices Commission or law enforcement, for staff, as appropriate.

District Web Site

The district's web site provides a resource for obtaining information about the district and for informing patrons about school activities, volunteer opportunities, meetings and district policies. Requests for publication of information on the district web site by administrators or others should be directed to the district technology coordinator. Personal information unrelated to the district's educational purpose will not be permitted.

Staff Web Pages

Staff may create web pages to use in class activities or to provide a resource for other staff members. Staff web pages must pertain to the curricular goals and objectives of the district or be associated with their individual planned professional growth plans.

Staff members linking outside sites to the district server are responsible for checking all material and links, ensuring conformance to copyright regulations, prior to submitting them to the district technology coordinator.

Individual Student Web Pages

Students may, with staff sponsorship and oversight, create web pages for publication on the district's web site that are primarily academic, educational and research oriented.

Student work and/or recognizable photographs of students may be published only with parent permission and only if related to a class project or activity. Such work shall not reveal personally identifiable information or prohibited directory information.

Student-created web pages reflect the individual and do not represent the district. Concerns about the content of any page created by a student should be directed to the school principal.

Student web pages may be removed at various junctures during the school year by school personnel.

Clubs and Organizations

Web pages published as a service by student activity groups, clubs and other organizations (PTOs, booster groups, etc.) may provide information about cocurricular and other school-authorized activities. All such web pages need to be approved by the district before being added to the district or school site.
