Alternative Education Notification and Evaluation

1. General

Each year building principals shall include the available provisions in the student-parent handbook. This information will be updated each year to reflect current programs. Handbooks will be distributed to all parents. Parents will be required to sign a form acknowledging that they have received a copy of the handbook.

2. Individual Notification

a. Individual notices will be issued every six months to:

- (1) Students with severe discipline problems;
- (2) Students with erratic attendance;
- (3) Expelled students and/or students being considered for expulsion;
- (4) Students applying for exemption to compulsory attendance.

b. Notification by:

- (1) Hand delivery;
- (2) Certified mail.

3. Program

Generally, the district will offer the following proposals for alternative choices to regular public education:

- a. Bound Instruction (provided by the district);
 - b. Glendale Alternative School;
 - c. Simultaneous enrollment in another accredited school or by independent study through an accredited program;
 - d. Other individual options as approved by the superintendent.
4. Each student will be given a personalized written program based on his/her education, social, legal, family situation and needs. A progress and exiting report will be completed on each student in line with the accepted student record keeping practices of the district.
5. An annual evaluation of the alternative education programs will be implemented by the superintendent.
