Grading System

District grading practices at the secondary level will follow the recommendations of the Oregon Association of Secondary School Principals and the College Admissions Officers. Glendale High School will follow the A, B, C, D and F grading system as the cumulative grade point average (GPA) for college determined at the end of the seventh semester. Generally, grades are defined as follows:

A = Superior scholarship	4 grade points
B = Above average performance	3 grade points
C = Average performance (doing what is required)	2 grade points
D = Below average, generally not acceptable for college	1 grade point
F = Failure, no credit	0 grade point

The A, B and C grades, as a general rule, will be followed in the elementary school; however, the GPA need not be calculated for these levels. The primary is authorized to use a different grading system if the staff study committee recommends such a system.
