

Use of Alcohol

Students who knowingly possess, use or are under the influence of alcohol on school grounds or at school sponsored activities at any time are subject to immediate suspension or expulsion. The student is subject as well to additional requirements and obligations established by the district.

First Offense (Suspension)

1. Suspend the student for five days.
2. Notify the parent of the student and request an immediate conference.
3. Notify law enforcement.
4. Require that for the student to be readmitted into the district educational programs, a chemical use evaluation be performed by a school-approved third party at the parent's expense. The administrator will supply information about any currently approved no-cost evaluations available in the area.
5. Require that the student on readmittance attend group or individual counseling sessions at school or within the community.
6. Recommend expulsion if there is failure on the part of the student to allow the evaluation.

Second Offense (Expulsion)

A second offense is an offense that occurs within 13 months of a first offense. The administrator shall:

1. Notify the parent requesting an immediate conference;
2. Suspend the student for five days pending written notice of an expulsion hearing;
3. Notify law enforcement.
