

Student Fund-Raising Activities

The Board recognizes that certain fund raisers or student sales activities have legitimate value as educational activities and provide needed financial support for approved student functions.

Students may carry out fund-raising activities in which no outside fund-raising group or contract is utilized, with permission of the principal and under the direct supervision of the appropriate advisers. Where funds are to be raised through an outside agency or contracted activity, the activity must received prior approval from the superintendent and must be closely monitored by the principal. Activities that include fund-raising for charitable or other causes not related to school activities must obtain prior approval from the superintendent.

If fund raising consists of selling food and beverage items to students during the regular or extended school day, the food and beverage items must comply with state and federal nutrition standards, rules and laws. This does not apply to food and beverage items sold at school-related or nonschool-related events for which parents and other adults are a significant part of the audience.

For the safety and security of our students, the Board discourages any fund raiser that has students going door to door without adult supervision.

Any student organization or outside group wishing to conduct a raffle, lottery or bingo game as part of a student fund-raising activity, must comply with state law regarding such activities. Any organization or group wishing to conduct a raffle, lottery or bingo game as part of a student fund-raising activity must provide the superintendent with proof of compliance with state law and have the superintendent's approval before advertising or conducting such activities
