Textbook Selection and Adoption

The Glide School District Board believes that proper care and judgment should be exercised in selecting basic textbooks for student use. While the Board retains the authority to approve district textbook adoptions, it authorizes the superintendent to develop and implement administrative procedures governing how selections are determined. Such procedures will provide for staff and parent involvement and employ suitable selection criteria to ensure that the recommended textbooks:

1. Display fairness in their portrayal of people;
2. Contain appropriate readability levels;
3. Show consistency with the district's adopted curriculum content;
4. Provide for ease of teacher use;
5. Are attractive and durable;
6. Can be purchased at reasonable cost.
