Field Trips and Excursions

The Glide School District recognizes the value of special activities in the total curriculum and agrees that students profit from carefully planned experiences. Special activities are defined as learning experiences which extend beyond the physical boundaries of the classroom.

Student trips of exceptional value are to be encouraged. These trips must be of an educational nature, pertain to a specific element of the curriculum, and be integrated into the curriculum.

All requests for student trips should be submitted to the principal for approval prior to making arrangements. Building principals must insure that all requests for trips have proper chaperoning and will not cause extreme problems in the total educational program of their building.

Whenever possible and practical, the Board will provide transportation for these trips.

It shall be the policy of the Board to keep approval for trips within the limitations imposed by the budget, and limitations imposed by insurance coverage.

Students who are absent from classes as a result of attending field or other school activity trips with another class or bona fide school sponsored group shall be offered an opportunity to make up work, within a reasonable period of time, without penalty.

Students who are participating members in two or more extra-curricular activities whose schedules conflict shall be offered the opportunity to participate in the activity of their choice that day, without penalty except in instances where rules of participation are imposed by outside activity associations.
