

## **Student Dress and Grooming**

Any student or person present on school property or attending a school-related activity who violates the provisions of Board policy JFCA/KGBB, Student Dress and Grooming will be subject to the following procedures:

1. For the first violation, the student or person will be asked to remove or conceal the item that gives rise to the violation. The individual may be asked to leave school premises or the activity in order to remove or conceal the item giving rise to the violation. The student offender and his or her parents shall be informed, in writing, of the violation and cautioned that further violations may result in more severe discipline;
2. Second or subsequent violations of the dress code may subject the student offender to suspension or expulsion;
3. An item that violates the dress and grooming code may be confiscated by a principal or the superintendent if in the opinion of the principal or superintendent the offending item presents an immediate threat to the safety of students or school personnel or the orderly conduct of school activities. The confiscation of such an item shall be governed by the procedures established pursuant to JFCK/KGBA/GBECA-AR, Confiscation Procedure.
