Curriculum Design

Elementary Level

Students in any school in the district having any combination of grades kindergarten through eight shall receive instruction in language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, health education, physical education, music education and art education. The Board may grant exemptions when required by students' religious or cultural beliefs, or for students with special physical, sensory or other disabilities.

Secondary Level

Students in any secondary school in the district (grades 9-12) shall receive instruction in language arts/English, mathematics, social studies/history, citizenship/government, science, health education, physical education, consumer education/economics/personal finance, career education and electives. The electives may include, but are not necessarily limited to: art, metal shop, wood shop, typing, drivers education, foreign language, music, band, conservation, recordkeeping, psychology, home economics, weights and conditioning.

The district curriculum is designed to provide students with a range of preparation in academic areas as well as in developing values and behaviors in interpersonal relations, exploring leisure-time activities, community service, preparing for the work force and acquiring the broad spectrum of skills necessary for success in life.
