Work-Study Program

Definition

Work-study programs: Learning experiences in which the students explore career interests in occupational fields through a program not offered in the regular high school curriculum.

Rationale

There are many career opportunities for which the school district does not provide course work pertinent to these careers, so it coordinates a work experience program with employers that enables students to obtain on-the-job training in an occupation of their choice.

Implementation Procedures - Guidelines

1. Students will apply to the administrator or designee.
2. The student's application will indicate the proposed location of the work experience, the types of activities in which he/she will engage, the expected learning outcomes and how they relate to the student's educational goals, the tentative work schedule and other factors which the instructor deems necessary.
3. The student must meet attendance and performance standards in order to earn credit and satisfy competency requirements.
