Class Size

The district shall maintain class sizes and teacher assignments which promote effective practices consistent with the outcomes expected of each instructional program.

In determining class sizes the following shall be considered:

1. The teacher-student ratio of each class;
2. The total number of students assigned per teacher;
3. The number of subject preparations or grades per teacher;
4. The support staff available to each teacher;
5. The nature of the subjects taught in relation to each teacher's professional preparation;
6. The appropriateness of instructional facilities and equipment;
7. The course goals applicable to the particular class; and
8. The extent to which class size varies from general statewide practice.

These guidelines will serve as a model for planning and scheduling purposes. It is recognized that achieving this goal is dependent upon the financial ability of the district.
