**Special and Emergency Board Meetings**

**Special Meetings**

Special meetings may be called at any time by the chairperson or vice chairperson or a majority of the Board. Notice to the general public shall be made at least 24 hours in advance of such meetings.

**Emergency Meetings**

An emergency meeting is one called on less than 24 hours notice, may be held only if there is business that cannot wait for a special meeting. The meeting shall be "appropriate to the circumstances," and meeting minutes shall describe the actual emergency justifying less than 24 hours notice.

Notice of the meeting shall be given. Telephone calls to the media and interested parties shall be made, particularly to groups or individuals whose concerns are to be discussed. ORS 192.640(3).
