Safety and Health Program

The ESD will provide, as far as possible, safe and healthful working conditions for every employee of the district.

Goal

It is the goal of the ESD to maintain a safe and healthful working environment for all employees within its boundaries. This will be accomplished by:

1. Promoting and improving safety oriented behavior.
2. Providing for preventative and emergency procedures in handling safety and health problems and reducing occupations hazards and accidents.
3. Encouraging employees in the safety methods while at work in the district.
4. The ESD has a Health & Safety Committee composed of ESD office staff. This committee meets annually to discuss and review the health and safety conditions of the ESD workplace, along with any concerns ESD employees may have.
5. Buildings will be planned, equipped and maintained in accordance with appropriate local, state and federal regulations.
6. Buildings will be provided with alarm systems, fire extinguishers and other safety devices required by state and federal laws and regulations.
