Board Member Ethics

Board members will treat other Board members, the superintendent, staff and members of the public with dignity and courtesy and will provide an opportunity for all parties to be heard with due respect for their opinions.

Board members will recognize the superintendent as the executive officer to whom the Board has delegated administrative authority to establish regulations and oversee the implementation of Board policy.

A Board member has the right to express personal opinions. When expressing such opinions in public, the Board member should clearly identify the opinions as his/her own.

A Board member must respect the privacy rights of individuals when dealing with confidential information gained through association with the district.

Board members individually and the Board as a public entity subscribe to the Code of Ethics for public officials, as stated in state law.

It is recognized that Board members may have a child or children who are Grants Pass School District No. 7 students. Board members will avoid any participation in matters calculated to have particular impact on their children's school program.
