Licensed Evaluation - Administrators

Each administrator will be evaluated as required by law by the superintendent or his/her designee. The superintendent will report to the Board annually on the performance of all administrators and make recommendations regarding their employment and/or salary status.

The purpose of administrator evaluations is to assist administrators to develop and strengthen their professional abilities, to improve the instructional program and to improve the management of the district. The administrator's written goals for the year as well as the continuing duties and responsibilities as defined in the job description for each position will be the basis for the evaluation.

The administrator being evaluated will have the right to attach a memorandum to the written evaluation and right of appeal through established grievance procedures, if applicable. The administrative evaluation system will also include provisions for initiating dismissal, contract non-extension or reassignment procedures if the need for such procedures is indicated.
