Staff Health and Safety

The Board authorizes the superintendent to take all necessary and appropriate means to provide for the health and safety of all employees while engaged in the performance of their duties.

The superintendent will develop written procedures and such training procedures as are necessary to accomplish this goal and to meet the requirements of the law.

All employees will be trained to recognize and respond appropriately to the presence of hazardous chemicals. All personnel who, during the performance of their duties or in an emergency, may be exposed to hazardous chemicals will be so informed and will be trained to deal appropriately with these chemicals.

If an employee is involved in an accident while in the line of duty, that person must file an accident report within 24 hours.
