High School Extracurricular Activity Eligibility

The Board believes that participation in high school extracurricular activities complements, reinforces and extends academic programs and offers opportunities for students to grow physically, intellectually and socially. Participation is a privilege, not a right, and students are expected to meet and maintain district eligibility standards in order to participate. Failure to meet and maintain academic achievement, satisfactory attendance and desirable behavior, as measured by the Grants Pass High School extracurricular activities code of conduct may result in discipline including probation, suspension and/or removal from the team/activity. This code of conduct is in addition to other school district policies applicable to student conduct under which students may be suspended or expelled from school.

As a member of the Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) and the Southern Oregon Conference (SOC), the district will adhere to OSAA and SOC policies and rules as well as the rules of the State Board of Education in all interscholastic athletic matters.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.
