## Alternative Instructional Programs

In addition to the regular curriculum and courses offered, it is possible for students to obtain credit from the following activities:

1. Enrollment in courses of other educational institutions;
2. Correspondence courses;
3. Educational travel;
4. Independent study;
5. Vocational work experience;
6. Challenge program;
7. Off-campus experiences.

The experiences shall be integrally related to the school curriculum and subject to the same standards of quality and competency skills. Experiences should be based on the student's interests, abilities, educational goals and objectives and should be described in a specific written agreement between parent, school, outside agency and student. Application for alternative instructional experience must be filed on the form provided, prior to taking the course.

An administrator shall be responsible for the coordination of this program and will be directly responsible to the principal.
