Volunteers

Community patrons who voluntarily contribute their time and talents to the improvement and enrichment of the public schools' instructional and other programs are valuable assets. The Board encourages constructive participation of groups and individuals in the school to perform appropriate tasks during and after school hours under the direction and supervision of professional personnel.

Any person authorized by the district for volunteer service into a position having direct, unsupervised contact with students will be required to undergo an Oregon criminal records check.

Any volunteer who knowingly makes a false statement, as determined by the district, on a district volunteer application form may be denied the ability to volunteer in the district.

Recruitment, utilization, coordination and training of volunteers is the responsibility of administration and will be carried out as directed or delegated by the superintendent. Every effort should be made to utilize volunteer resources in a manner which will ensure maximum contribution to the welfare and educational growth of students.

Volunteers are under the direct supervision of building administration and services may be terminated at any time. Termination of services can be appealed to the superintendent.
