Admissions

Upon entering kindergarten, students shall present verification of date of birth (e.g., a birth certificate, a hospital record or a baptismal record). Students admitted to any other grade must show evidence of completing the prior school years.

Immunization records must be presented at the time the student is enrolled.

Any student whose fifth birthday falls on or before September 1 may enter kindergarten at the opening of school in September of the same year.

Any student whose sixth birthday falls on or before September 1 may enter the first grade at the opening of school in September of the same year.

Minimum age requirements shall be waived for any student who has been attending public school in a state or area which has an entrance age different from that of Oregon.

A student enrolling in kindergarten or first grade from a private school shall comply with the state-mandated age requirements. A student enrolling from a state registered private school will be entered in grades two through eight according to appropriate grade sequence.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission solely because the student does not have a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence or solely because the student is not under the supervision of a parent.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission where they are otherwise eligible, not receiving special education, and not yet attained the age of 19 prior to the beginning of the current school year.

The district may admit an otherwise eligible person who is not receiving special education and who has not yet attained 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year if the person is shown to be in need of additional education in order to receive a diploma.

Students who attend a district school on an interdistrict transfer or open enrollment are considered residents of the district.

Students living in the district who have attained the age of majority are considered residents of the district.

Minor students living with a parent or guardian who resides in the district are considered residents of the district.

Students who are wards of the court and who are placed in the district are residents of the district.
