Solicitations in the Schools

There shall be no soliciting of funds, distribution of literature or other activity for political purposes by the employees of the district while on duty. Principals shall be responsible for the enforcement of this policy in the buildings under their control.

It is the policy of the district to restrict the sending home of literature with children to things which are directly related to the welfare of the school and the children. It shall further be the policy to discourage, or even prohibit, the sending home of letters, pamphlets, notes or literature advertising a private business, a political candidate, a social event or legislation not directly connected to the welfare of the school or the children.

Students shall not be allowed to solicit or sell for any outside organizations as representatives of the school or as representatives of any school organization without specific authorization of the building principal.

Solicitation of donations from students by fund-raising organizations from outside the schools tends to defeat educational values, may embarrass students and frequently may duplicate appeals made to the same home. Therefore, it is the policy of the Board that no collections by representatives of external organizations shall be made in the schools.
