21st Century Schools Councils

The district shall have 21st Century Schools Councils at each school. 21st Century Schools Councils shall consist of the following:

Membership

Membership shall include the following:

Membership	Selection	Requirements
Teachers, required	Elected by licensed	Shall serve teachers at school site
Classified, required	Elected by classified	Shall serve employees at school site
Building administrator or designee, required	Appointed by building administrator or designee	Shall serve
Parents of students, required	Appointed by parents of students at that site	Shall serve by a process to be defined by the Board

Duties

Within the parameters established above, 21st Century Schools Councils shall be responsible for the development of plans to improve the professional growth of the school staff, the improvement of the school’s instructional program, the development and coordination of plans for the implementation of programs under ORS Chapter 329 at the school, the administration of grants-in-aid for the professional development of teachers and classified employees as provided for in Oregon Revised Statutes and Oregon Administrative Rules. Additional duties shall be set by Board policy.

Limitation of Council Authority

The district mission, beliefs, goals, priorities, strategic plan and policies shall continue to be established at the district level and approved by the Board. These establish the guiding framework within which 21st Century Schools Councils will develop school improvement plans.

All 21st Century Schools Council decisions are subject to superintendent and Board review and approval, respectively. 21st Century Schools Council decisions shall not abrogate any provisions of the district's collective bargaining agreements, other Board contracts, Board policy or law, except through the waiver process.

Public Meetings Law

21st Century Schools Councils, the duties of which include advising the Board or making decisions on behalf of the Board, shall follow the notice, meeting and record-keeping requirements of the Public Meetings Law.
