Student Social Events

Students and invited guests will not be permitted to leave the building and return during a dance or activity without first obtaining permission from the teacher supervising.

There will be no smoking in the school building.

Any student who has been drinking will not be admitted to any school-sponsored activity.

There will be no alcohol or drugs allowed at school activities.

The closing hour of all social functions is 9 p.m. for elementary-age students and 12 a.m. for high school students.

Chaperone Duties

It is the duty of the chaperon to aid and assist the staff member at dances or activities. Your duty is to be both mother and father to all of the students at the dance. Our students are not to leave the dance until they are ready to leave for home. If a student or invited guest needs to leave for some reason and wishes to return, they must clear with the staff advisor. All chaperons must stay until the building is closed following the activity.

Responsibility

The chaperon, staff advisor and administration are responsible and will take care of any problems. They should be contacted if necessary.
